Kiwi Skate is a nationally recognized Learn to Skate program for children from the age of 3 to 18 years old

Course Outline

Class time runs for a duration of 50 minutes; included in this time is a group warm up and game time. Skaters will be instructed in groups assigned by the coaches to best suit their abilities where the skaters are taught skills to enhance their competence on the ice.

The games are created especially for the Kiwi skate program to help increase skaters confidence and agility.

Test days occur throughout the term, giving skaters the chance to move up through the grades as they are eligible. This achievement is marked with a certificate, and the opportunity to purchase "Kiwi Skate Badges".

Clothing

We recommend skaters wear winter jackets, long trousers (preferably not jeans), thick socks, a hat & gloves.

Skate Fitting

Skaters should be able to wiggle their toes; however the foot should not slip inside of the boot. Skates should be tied firmly, right from the base of the laces to the hooks. Please do not hesitate to ask one of the coaches for help in regards to fastening skates, as they are happy to help.
